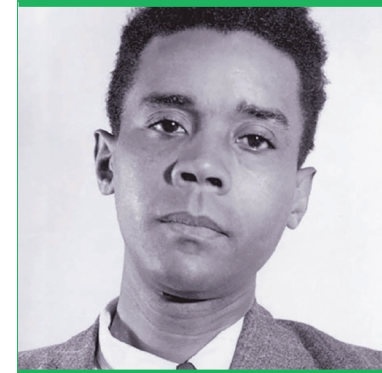
LAMBETH LOCAL HISTORY FORUM
